

St. Louis Park Historical Society

The St. Louis Park Historical Society was created in 1971 with the Mission to Collect, Preserve and Disseminate Knowledge about the History of St. Louis Park.

The Society Operates Two Sites: The St. Louis Park Depot in Jorvig Park, 3700 Brunswick Ave. and the Lenox Community Center, 6715 Minnetonka Boulevard

Meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month: At the Depot from June-September and the balance of the year at Lenox Community Center.

St. Louis Park Historical Society Activities and Goals

- * The Lenox Community Center Site is open Monday and Thursday mornings from 10:00 AM to Noon.
- * The Depot in Jorvig Park is open on Saturday afternoons between 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM from June 1 to October 1.
- * Both facilities may be opened at other times by appointment.
- * The Society has published a history of St. Louis Park, "Something In The Water". It can be purchased for \$ 20.00
- * The Society publishes a news letter, "Re-Echo", 4 times a year, available to all interested persons
- * Working with the St. Louis Park teachers to continue and improve a St. Louis Park History sequence for 7th grade students.
- * Continue to produce "Oral Histories" in cooperation with St. Louis Park City Hall Community TV and make them available on Community TV15.
- * Maintain the Depot in Jorvig Park as a "Railroad Museum", including a model rail road exhibit.
- * Continue to be available to make St. Louis Park history presentations to community organizations.
- * Continue to computerize the Society's collections with goal of providing accessibility on a St. Louis Park Historical Society web site.
