RESOLUTION SUPPORTING
MINORITY-OWNED BUSINESS,
WOMEN'S BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND
SMALL BUSINESS

WHEREAS, the City Council met and discussed the importance of small and minority-owned businesses and women's enterprises in contracting, professional services and purchasing.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS PARK AS FOLLOWS:

The City of St. Louis Park is committed to encourage and support minority-owned business and women's business enterprises and small business, as defined by SBA regulations, when prudent as it relates to contracting, professional services and purchasing. Such efforts shall:

- A. Including such firms upon their request, when qualified, on solicitation electronic mailing lists;
- B. Dividing total requirements, when economically prudent, into smaller tasks or quantities to permit participation by such firms;
- C. Establishing delivery schedules, where the requirement permits, which encourage participation by such firms;
- D. Using the services and assistance of organizations such as the SBA (Small Business Association), MWBE (Minority and Women Business Enterprises) and MN-NAWBO (National Association of Women Business Owners);
- E. Encourage prime contractors, when subcontracting is anticipated, to take the positive steps listed above.
