Sec. 10-1. Ward lines established.

Ward lines of the city are hereby determined, and the city is divided into four separate wards, as follows:

- (1) Ward No. 1. Ward No. 1 is as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north city limits and the Soo Line Railroad tracks, south along the Soo Line tracks to the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks, west along the Burlington Northern tracks to Louisiana Avenue South, south along Louisiana Avenue to Minnetonka Boulevard, east along Minnetonka Boulevard to the Soo Line Railroad Tracks, south along the Soo Line tracks to State Highway No. 7, east along State Highway No. 7 to State Highway 100, north along Highway 100 to Minnetonka Boulevard, east along Minnetonka Boulevard to Lynn Ave South, south on Lynn Avenue to State Highway No. 7, east along State Highway 7 to the east city limits, north along the east city limits to the north city limits, west/northwest along the north city limits to its intersection with the Soo Line Railroad Tracks.
- (2) Ward No. 2. Ward No. 2 is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the Soo Line Railroad Tracks with west city limits, south and east along the west city limits to the south city limits, easterly along the south city limits to the east city limits, north and east along the east city limits to State Highway 7, west along State Highway No. 7 to Lynn Avenue South, north on Lynn Avenue to Minnetonka Boulevard, west along Minnetonka Boulevard to State Highway 100 South, south along Highway 100 to State Highway No. 7, west along State Highway No. 7 to the Soo Line tracks, south along the Soo Line tracks to the Southwest Regional Southwest Transit Corridor tracks, west on the Southwest Transit Corridor tracks to its intersection with the west city limits.
- (3) Ward No. 3. Ward No. 3 is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks with the west city limits, south along the west city limits to the south city limits, east along the south city limits to Texas Avenue South (west city limits), south along Texas Avenue to the Southwest Transit Corridor tracks, east along the Southwest Transit Corridor Tracks to the Soo Line tracks, north along the Soo Line tracks to Minnetonka Boulevard, west along Minnetonka Boulevard to Louisiana Avenue South, north along Louisiana Avenue to 28th Street West, west on 28th Street West to Virginia Avenue South, north on Virginia Avenue South to the Burlington Northern tracks, southwesterly along the Burlington Northern tracks to its intersection with the west city limits.
- (4) Ward No. 4. Ward No. 4 is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north city limits with the west city limits, southeasterly along the west city limits to the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks, easterly along the Burlington Northern tracks to Virginia Avenue South, south on Virginia Ave South to 28th Street West, east on 28th Street West to Louisiana Ave South, north on Louisiana Ave South to the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks, east along the Burlington Northern Tracks to the Soo Line Railroad tracks, north along the Soo Line tracks to the north city limits, west/northwest along the north city limits to its intersection with the west city limits.

Sec. 10-2. Absentee ballot counting board.

The city council authorizes an absentee ballot counting board and further authorizes the election judges of such board to receive, examine and validate absentee ballots. The further duties of such board shall be those provided by statute.
