The Beltline Transit Station will be located just east of Beltline Blvd. within the Cedar Lake Trail/rail corridor. The Beltline Station is one of three planned Southwest Light Rail Transit (LRT) stations that will be located in St. Louis Park. The City is studying the Beltline station area in order to help guide public investment and private development.
