Permits for 24 hours or less: Applicant must notify in writing all immediate neighbors of time, date, and type of event for the permit issued. Please submit a copy to the City with application.

Permits for over 24 hours: Applicant must submit to the City with the temporary noise permit application a set of address labels officially approved by the county auditor's office for all property owners within 350 feet of the parcel boundaries. Approval or denial will be considered after any public comment is received.

A Temporary Noise Permit does not exempt a permit holder from complying with all orders from a responding police officer in the event of a complaint during the time of the event.

Pursuant to meeting the requirements of the St. Louis Park Ordinance code, permission is hereby granted/denied to said above applicant for a temporary noise permit for the above dates and time.
