Enclosed is the 2012 Courtesy Bench License application. **You are required to complete the application and return with payment before January 1, 2012. Any application and payment received after January 1, 2012 will be subject to a late fee of either \$50 or 25% of the license fee, whichever is greater.**

The council approved all fees at the October 3, 2011 meeting. The 2012 license fee is \$45 per bench. **Please enclose a list of bench locations in St. Louis Park.** Payment is due at the same time the application is submitted. The application must be postmarked no later than December 31, 2011. Any applications received after that date will be subject to the late fee. We have the capability of accepting cash, check (payable to the City of St. Louis Park) or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express) are accepted.

The City has received notice from the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry that all licensed businesses must complete and submit a "Certificate of Compliance" form proving evidence of compliance with the workers' compensation insurance coverage requirement by MN Statutes Chapter 176. This **signed form is in addition** to any other required license insurance certificates and will be required with license renewals each year going forward. **Please complete and sign the enclosed form and return with your license application.**

If your Workers' Compensation policy is ever cancelled within the license period, you are required to notify the City by resubmitting this form. If you have any questions regarding the new policy please contact the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry at 651-284-5005.

Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law

THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY ALL BUSINESS TYPES

PRINT IN INK or TYPE.

Minnesota Statutes, Section 176.182 requires every state and local licensing agency to withhold the issuance or renewal of a license or permit to operate a business or engage in any activity in Minnesota until the applicant presents acceptable evidence of compliance with the workers' compensation insurance coverage requirement of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 176. If the required information is not provided or is falsely stated, it shall result in a \$2,000 penalty assessed against the applicant by the commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry.

A valid workers' compensation policy must be kept in effect at all times by employers as required by law.
