2012 Pavement Management Project

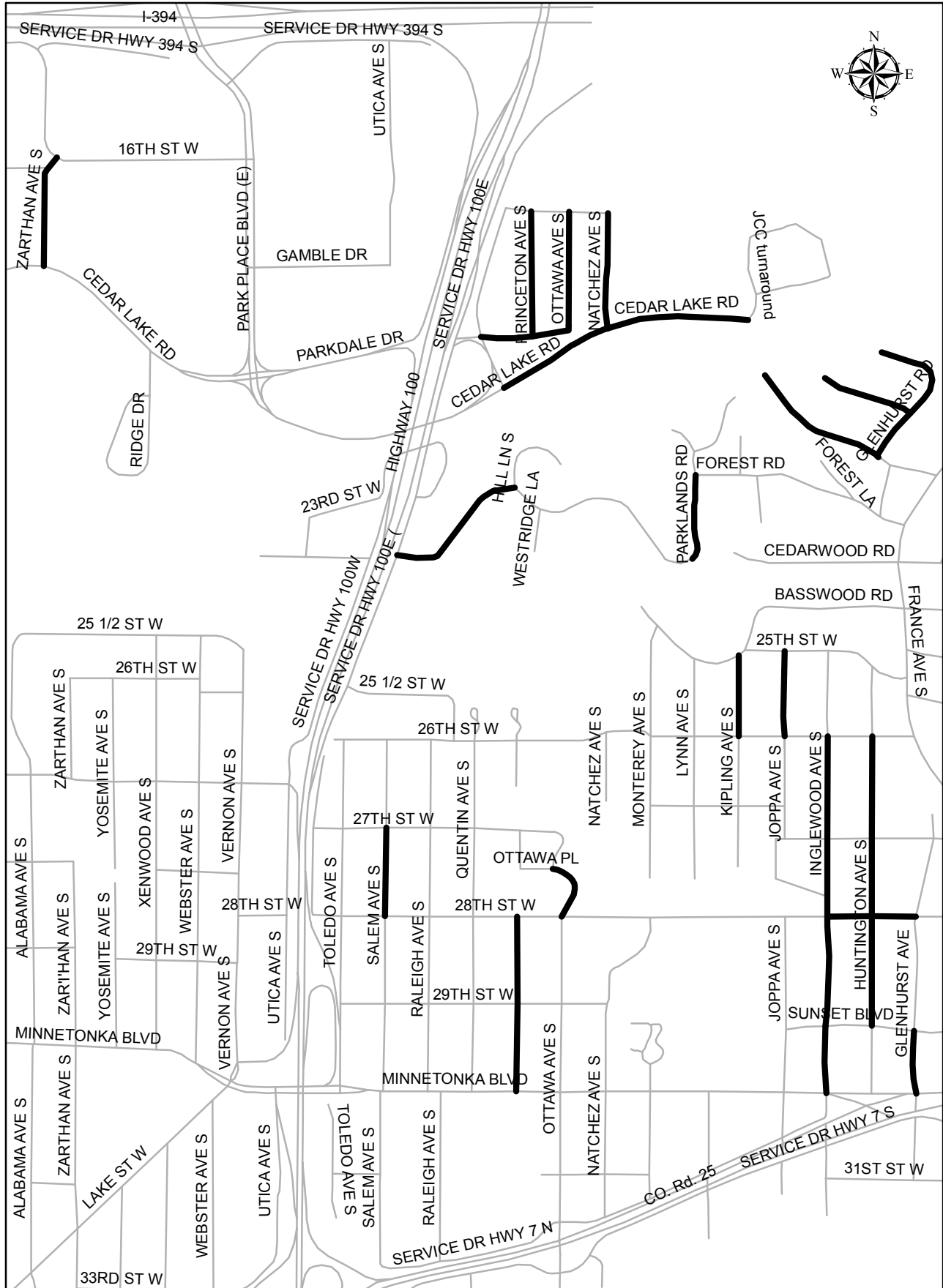
In 2012, the City of St. Louis Park is planning to rehabilitate the street in front of your home. This work will include replacing the asphalt pavement and portions of the old curbing which may be failing. A map of the project area is provided on the back of this letter.

In order to begin preliminary design of the project, city staff will be surveying the street and adjacent boulevard areas. Once the survey information has been gathered, our engineering staff will begin drawing preliminary plans for the proposed work. During this winter, staff will host a neighborhood meeting to allow residents to view and comment on the plans. Final plans will then be completed and presented to the City Council for approval. Bids for the project are solicited in late winter and construction typically begins in late May.


During the construction in 2012, the curbing along your property may be replaced. Should you have an underground irrigation system or invisible dog fence adjacent to the curb, it will be necessary for you to temporarily remove it during construction to prevent it from being damaged.
