

Ordinance No. ____-18

An ordinance vacating drainage and utility easements located on Lot 1, Block 2, Louisiana Alignment

The City of St. Louis Park does ordain:

Section 1. The petition by the City to vacate drainage and utility easements located on Lot 1, Block 2, Louisiana Alignment has been duly filed. The notice of said petition has been published in the *St. Louis Park Sailor* on October 25, 2018 and the city council has conducted a public hearing upon said petition and has determined that the easement is not needed for public purposes, and that it is for the best interest of the public that said easement be vacated.

Section 2: The following described drainage and utility easement as now dedicated and laid out within the corporate limits of the City of St. Louis Park, is vacated:

All of the dedicated drainage and utility easements over, under and across Lot 1, Block 2, Louisiana Alignment, according to the recorded plat t hereof, Hennepin County, Minnesota

Section 3. The City Clerk is instructed to record certified copies of this ordinance in the Office of the Hennepin County Register of Deeds or Registrar of Titles as the case may be.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after its publication.
