

2020 fee assistance information

The City of St. Louis Park provides a program for St. Louis Park residents that may need financial assistance to participate in our recreation programs. It is the policy of the City of St. Louis Park to provide services to all residents regardless of sex, race, color, national origin or financial status.

Who is eligible?

St. Louis Park residents who meet certain income guidelines.

How much assistance can my family receive?

Each eligible family member can receive a maximum of \$160 in fee assistance per calendar year (January – December). Participants must pay the first 50 percent of the eligible program or activity fee.

Example: Approved participant wishes to register for a summer program which costs \$35. The participant would pay \$17.50, and the city would provide the other \$17.50. The participant's account of \$160 would then be reduced by \$17.50, leaving \$142.50 available for the remainder of the year.

What income guidelines qualify my family for fee assistance?

Using the table below, find your family size. Then, find the income amount to the right of the family size. If your maximum total household income is at or below this amount and you meet the other criteria of age and residency, you would qualify for fee assistance. (If assistance is being requested for a foster child, the foster care income and family size of one should be indicated).

Special circumstances will be considered if your income exceeds the guidelines or if there are other extenuating circumstances. This fee reduction must be approved for each program.

What programs are eligible for fee assistance?

Special events and programs run by the City of St. Louis Park qualify, including parks and recreation special events and programs, Aquatic Park seasonal passes and Westwood Hills Nature Center programs.

What programs do not qualify for fee assistance?

Birthday party packages; facility rentals including ice rinks, party rooms and picnic shelters; and Westwood Hills Nature Center camps that include field trips.

Note: The city also approves fee assistance requests for St. Louis Park athletic associations when requested. For scholarship information for school district and Community Education programs, call 952.928.6777.
