Transfer photographs to VHS cassette; Transfer slides to VHS cassette; Transfer home movies (8mm) to VHS cassette; Simple editing by transferring personal VHS cassette recordings onto a different cassette; Duplicate personal VHS recordings; Add narration to a personal VHS recording; Add your personal background music to your own VHS recording; Record a video letter to family or friends, one that shows you talking on screen; Copy a phonograph record or open-reel tape to audio cassette or audio CD; Copy personal Betamax or VHS videos to VHS.

What does this cost? You must be a current member of the SLP Senior Program. The 1-2 hour activity fee of \$1 is payable in the activity office at Lenox Community Center, front office. All this is done using donated equipment. If this sounds interesting to you, please call to request a free transfer tip sheet, and arrange an appointment. Appointments are held in a conference room.
