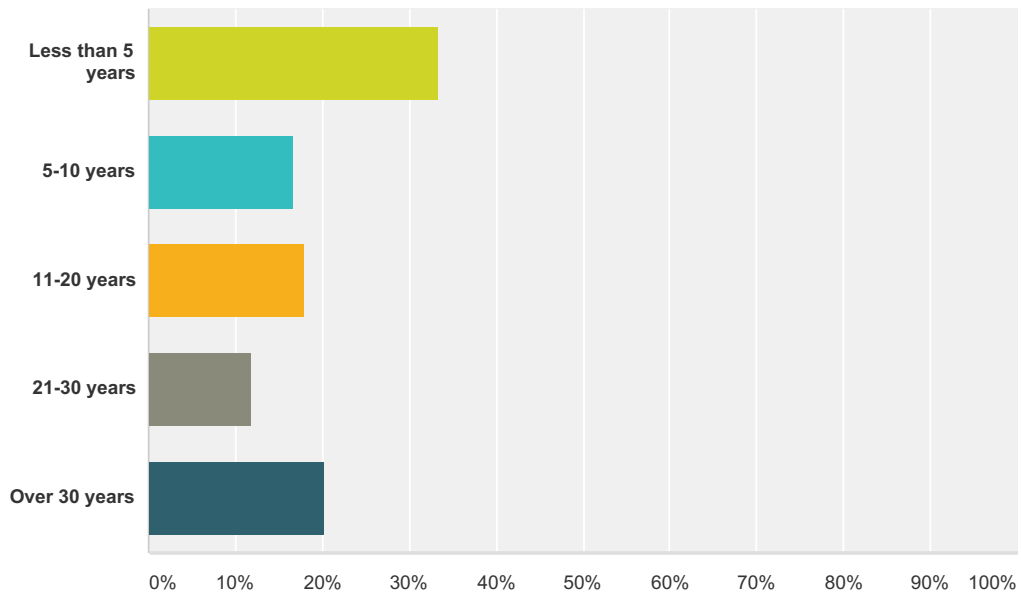

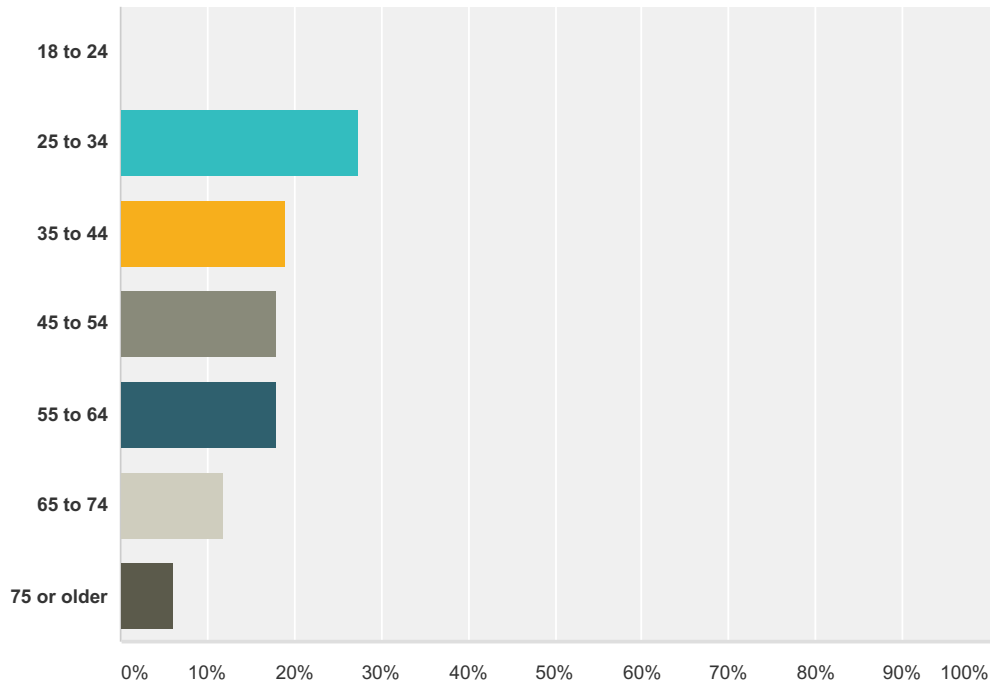

## Q2 What is your age?

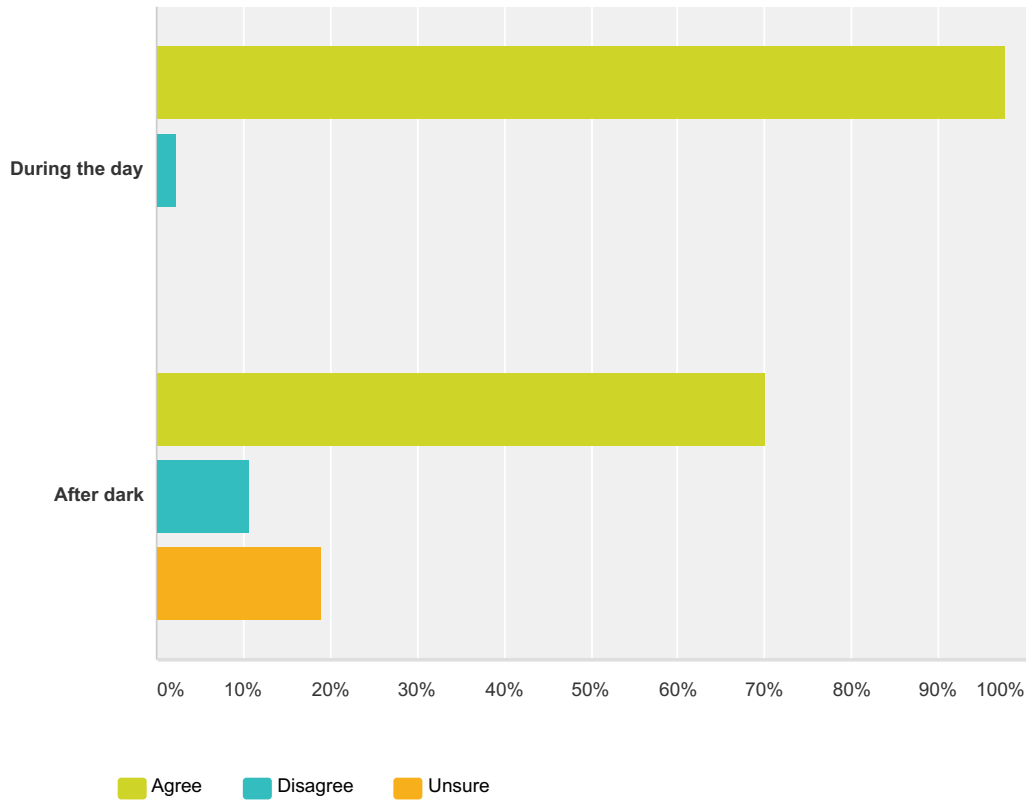

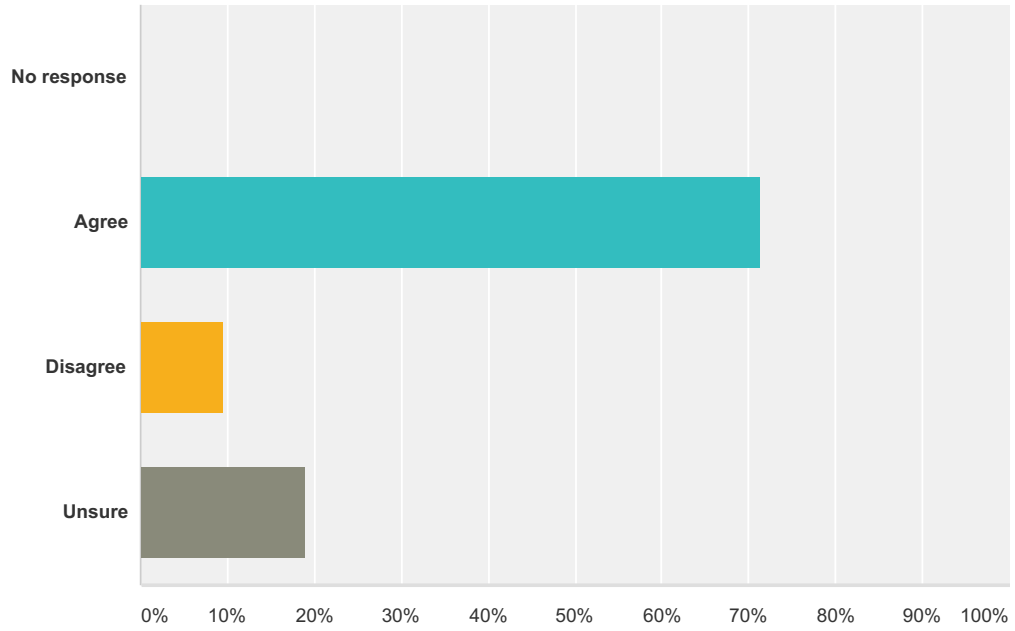

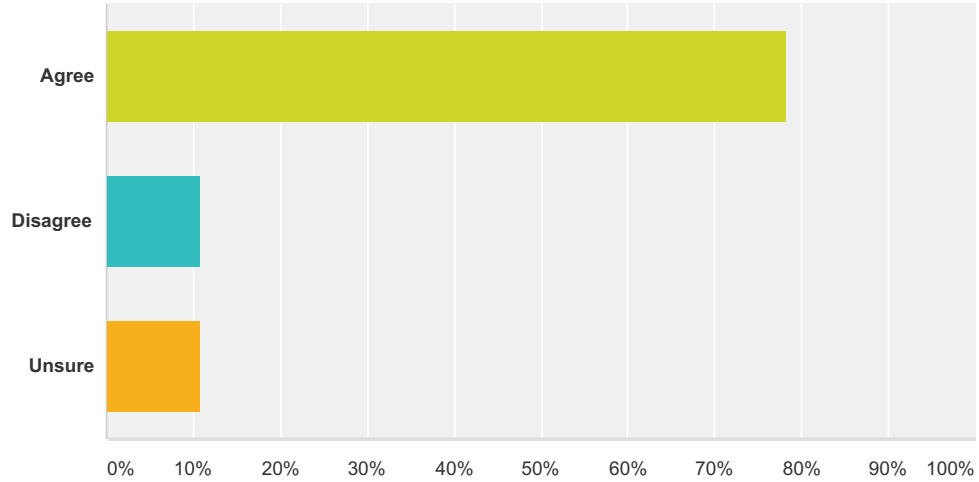

**Q5 If I had to be away from my home (example: vacation), I would ask my neighbor to watch my home.**

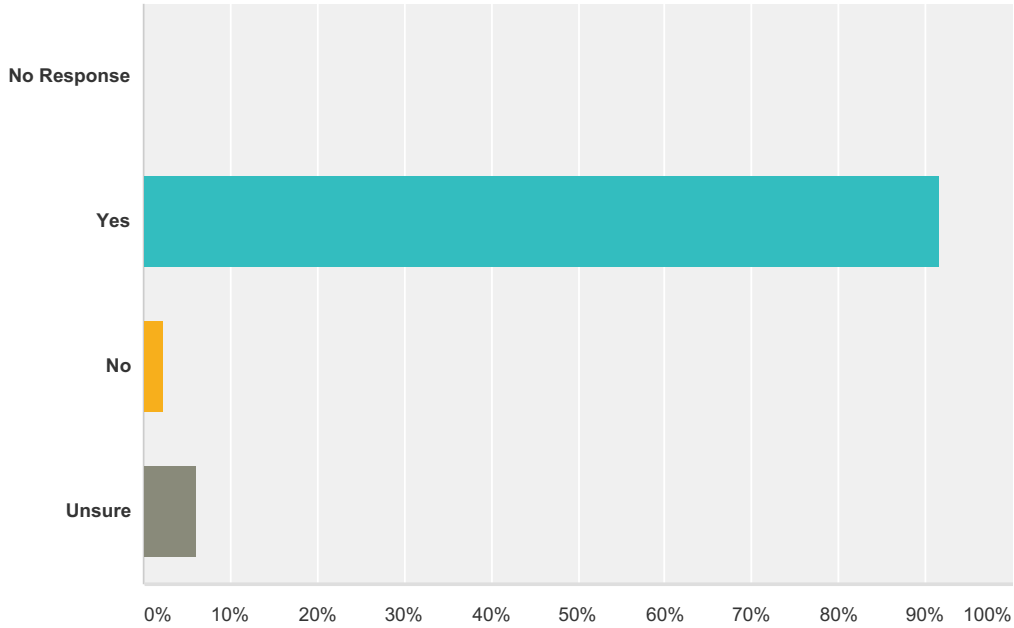

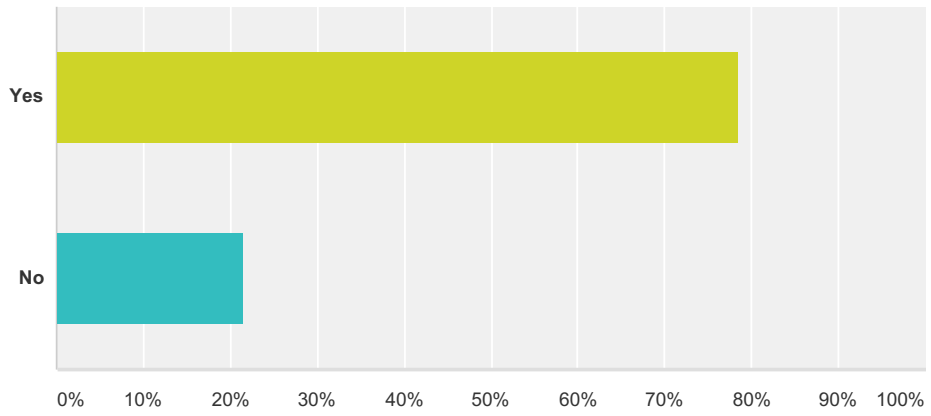

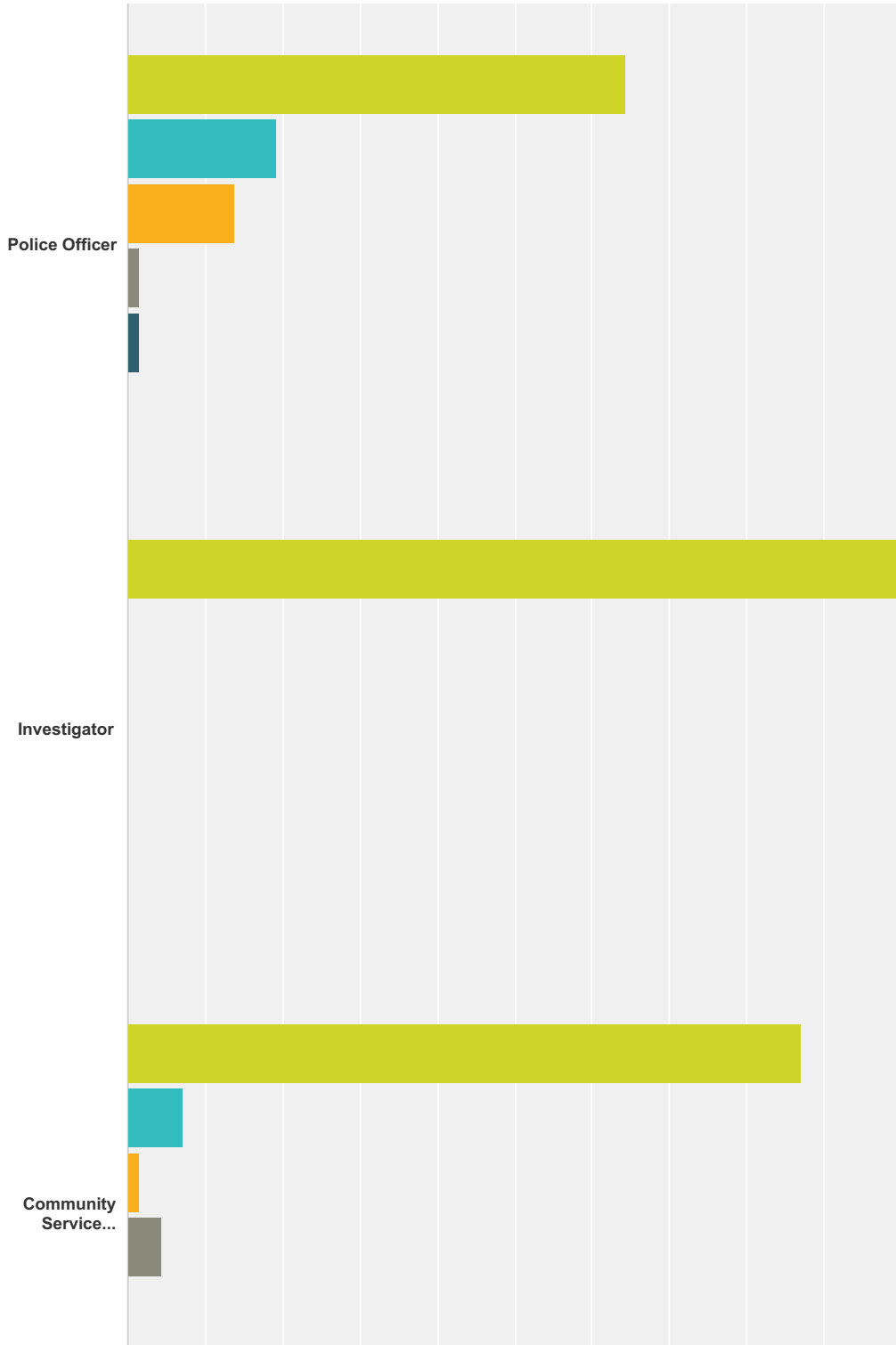
