



Q2 What is your age?











| 4 | Vehicular traffic: Huntington Ave, north of Lake/Mtka Blvd is used as a cut-through, especially now w/major construction. Vehicle speeds have increased, and attention to signs, etc--not so good. Huntington Ave doesn't have sidewalks on the 2600 block, nor does the cross street (Cedar Lk Ave), so pedestrians are in the street. This is a dangerous mix. Residents generally know, but cut-through traffic does not. Overall, arterial traffic (France Av/Cedar Lk Pkwy/Lake St/Mtka) has become so noticeably worse in the last year that drivers appear frustrated, adding to issues. This is a joint Minneapolis/SLP issue to resolve. Situation will not improve-in fact, likely to get worse with ongoing high-density construction along Hwy 7/Lake St, etc. Theft: Residents do not seem to take minimal security measures, so I believe neighborhood is "marked," known as an easy target for people who are looking for opportunity thefts. We have an alley behind us, and while marked as "no outlet," it has some amount of foot traffic from people we don't know/recognize. 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

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

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
