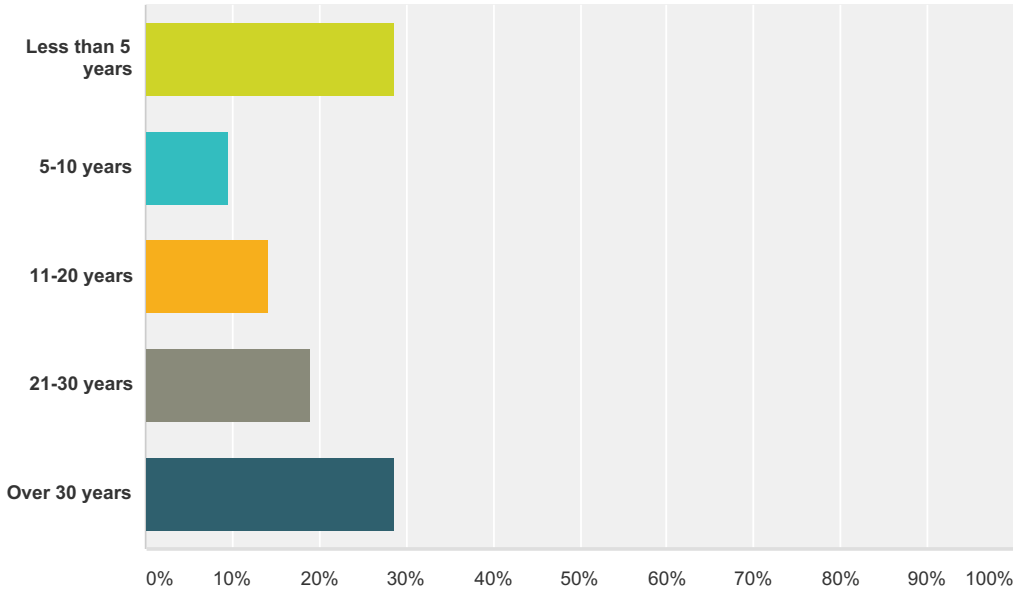


Q1 How many years have you lived in the Lake Forest Neighborhood?

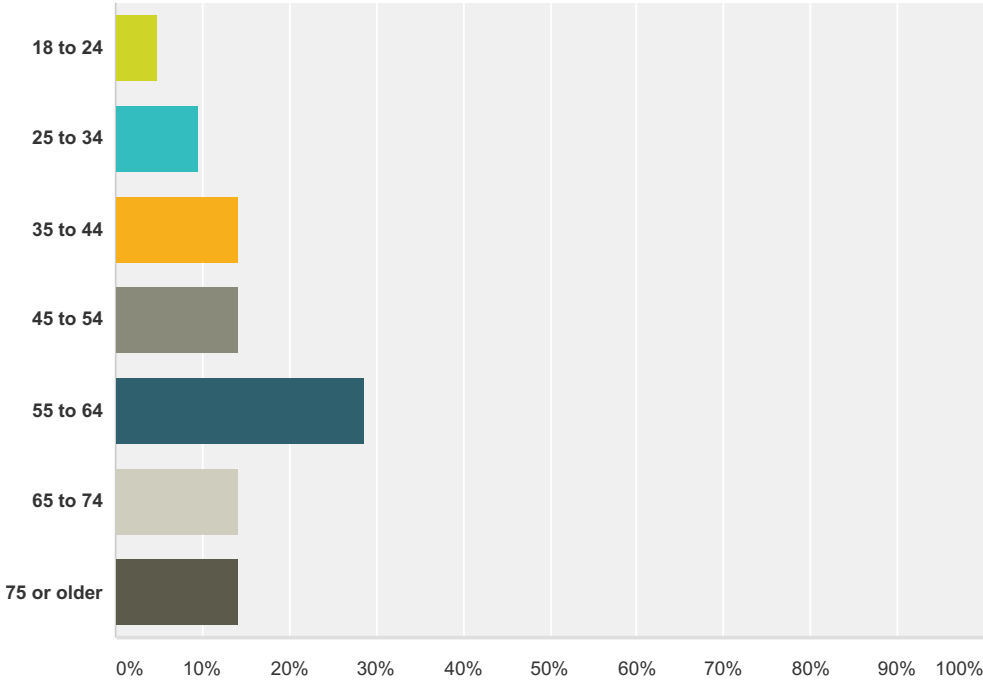

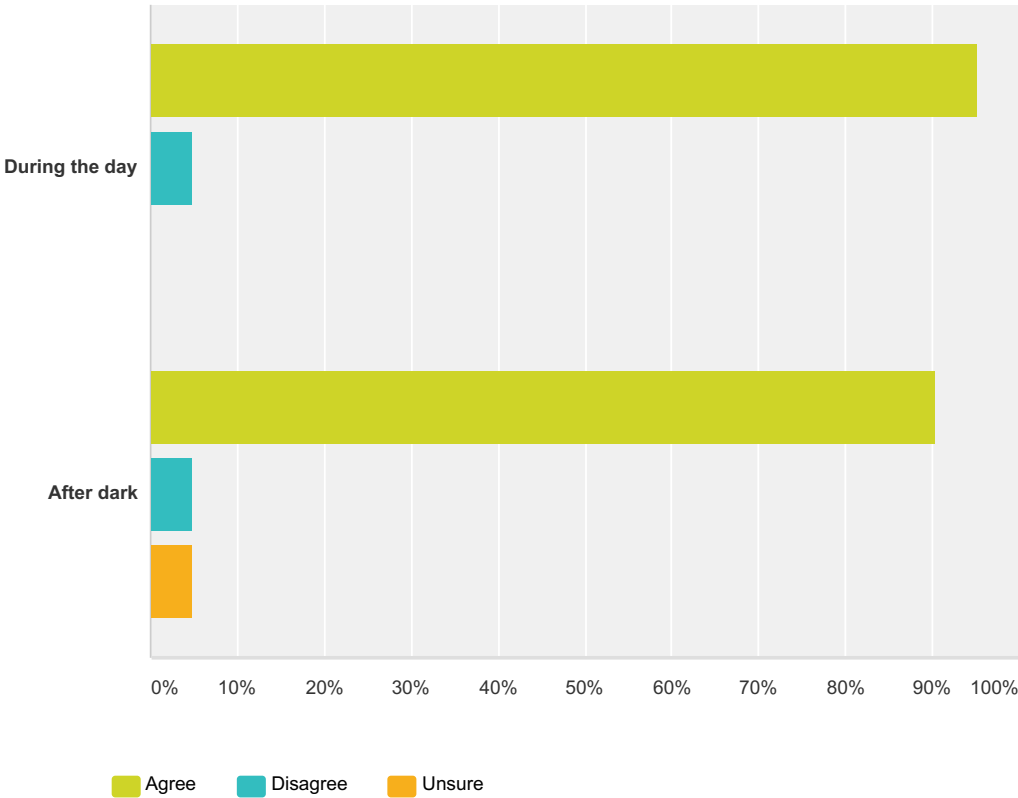

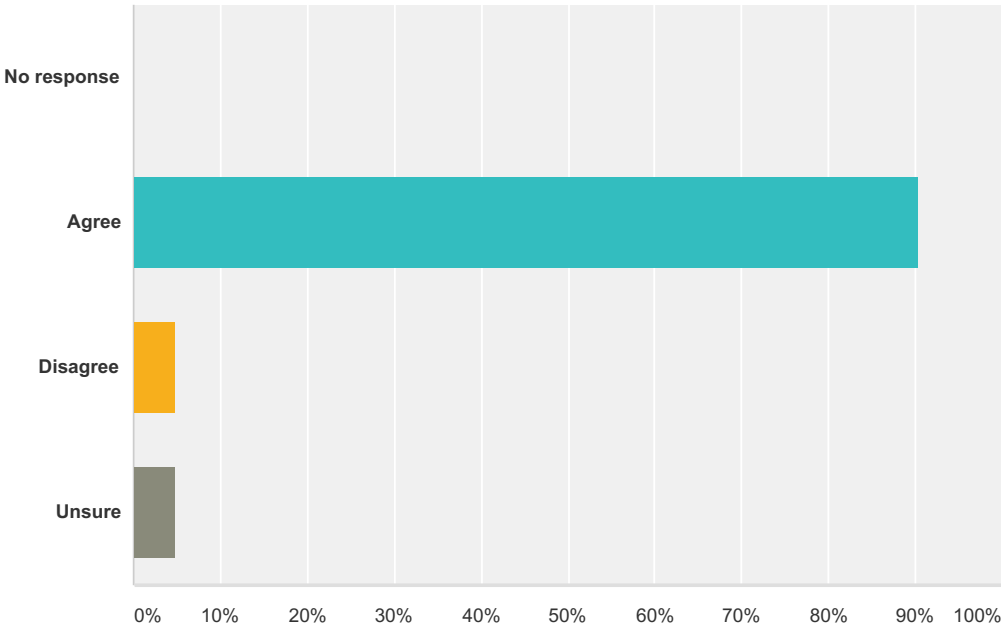

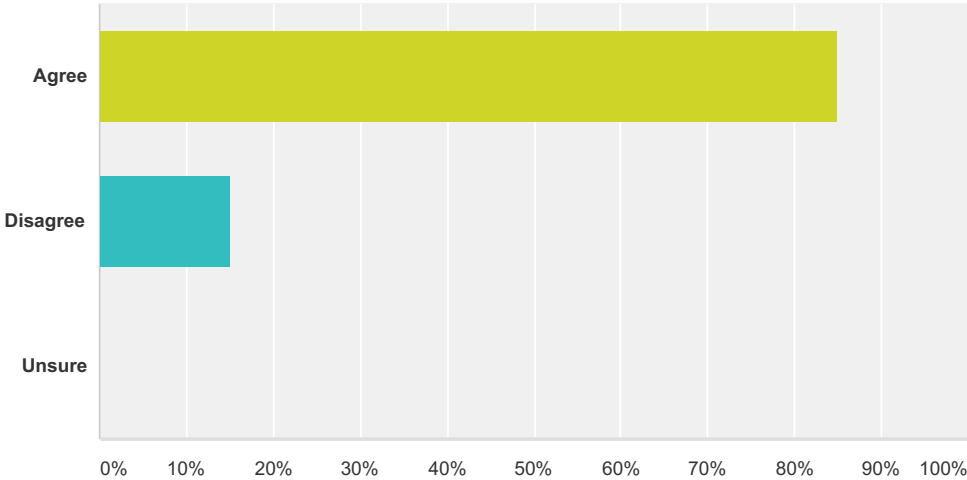

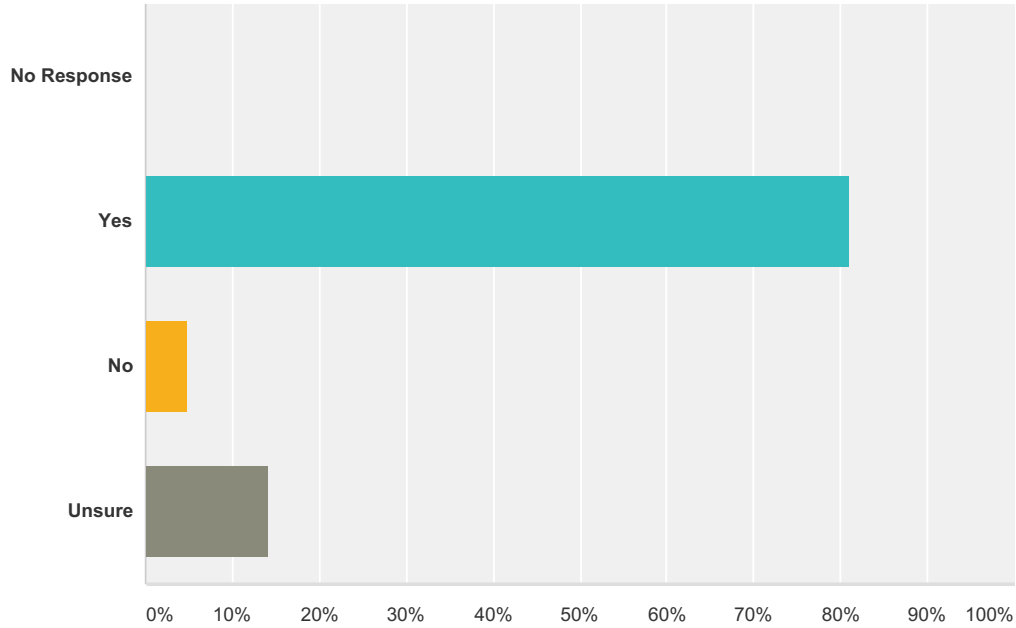

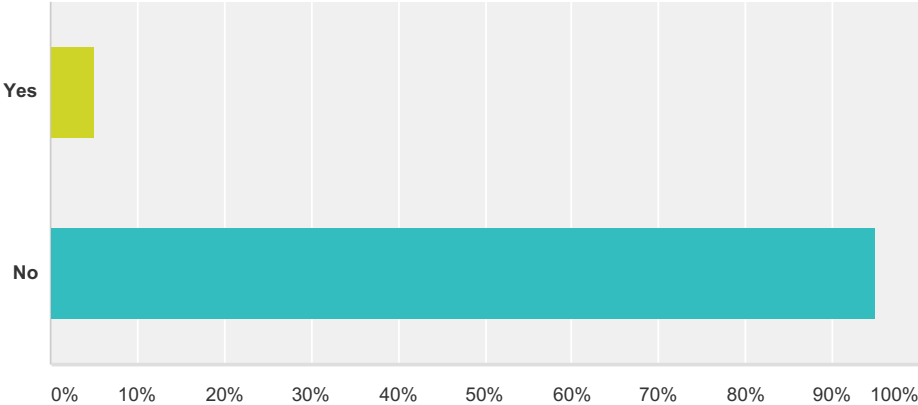
