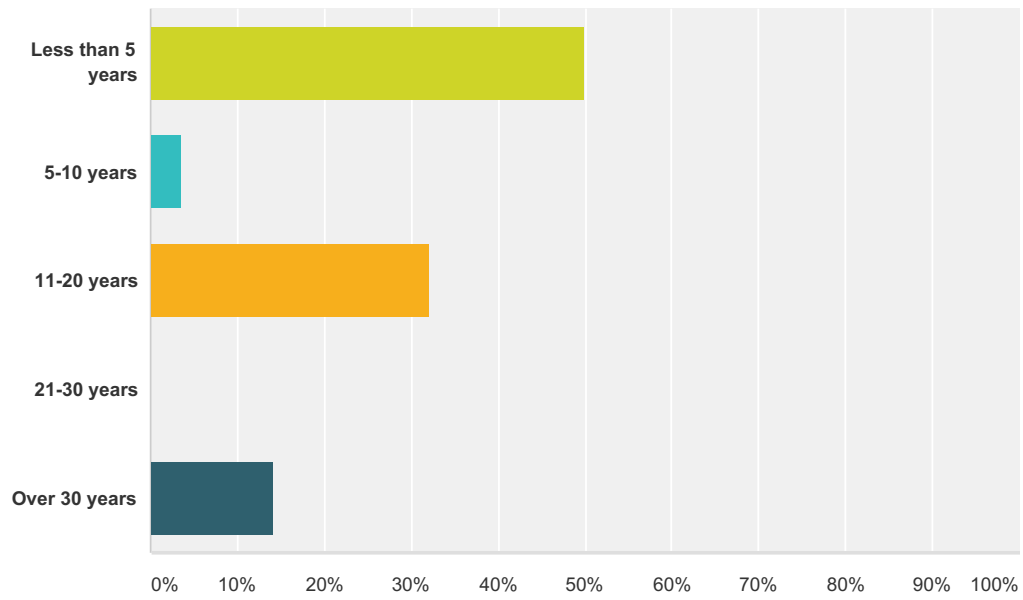


Q1 How many years have you lived in the Triangle Neighborhood?

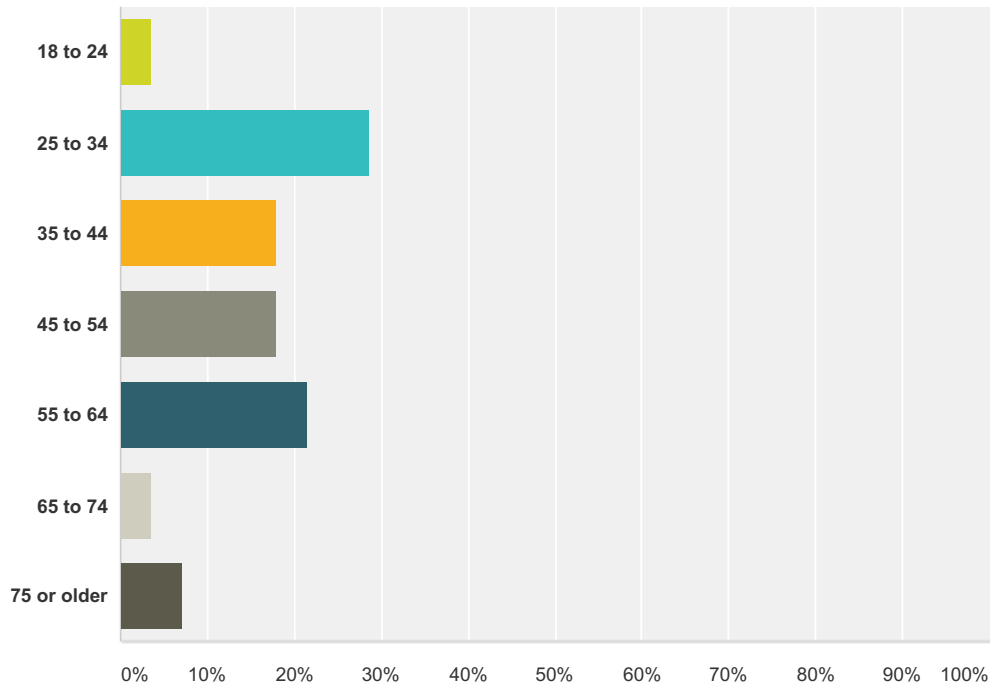

Q2 What is your age?

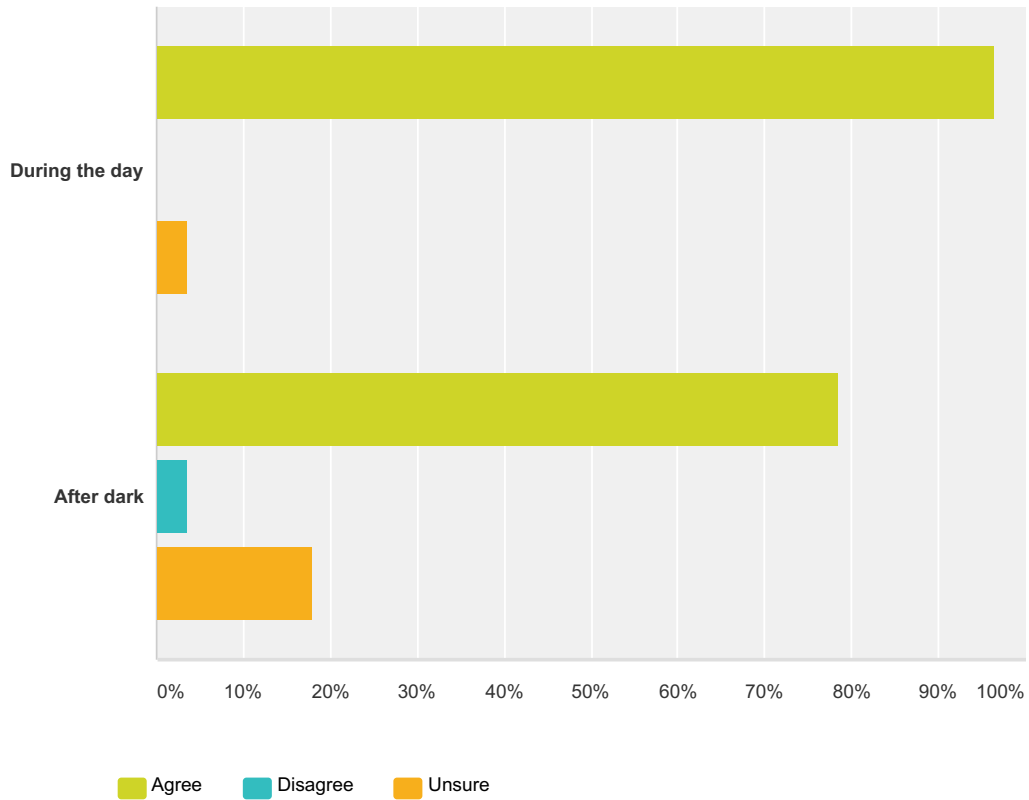

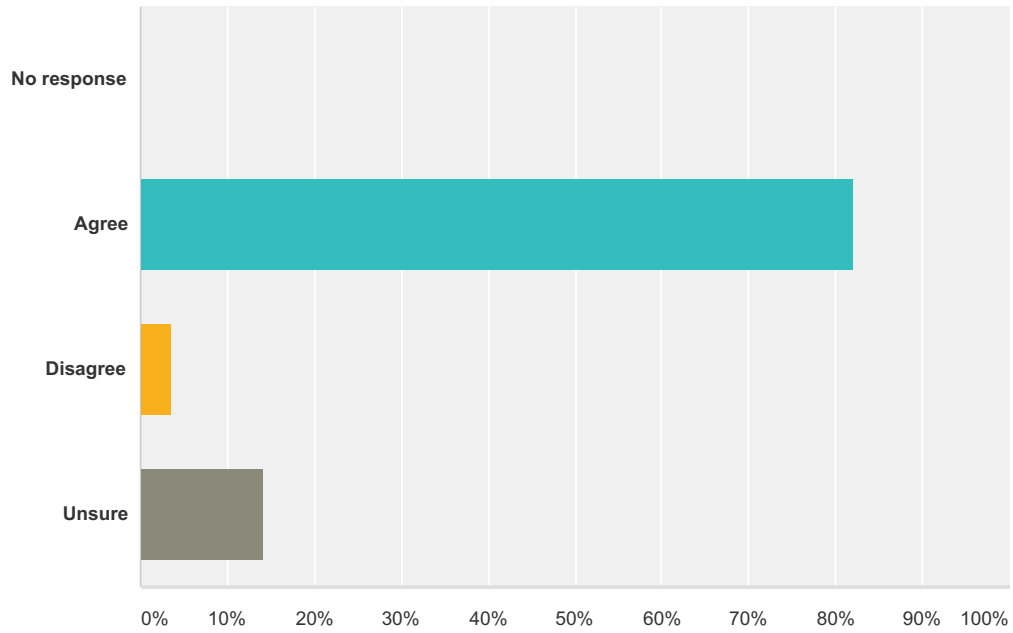

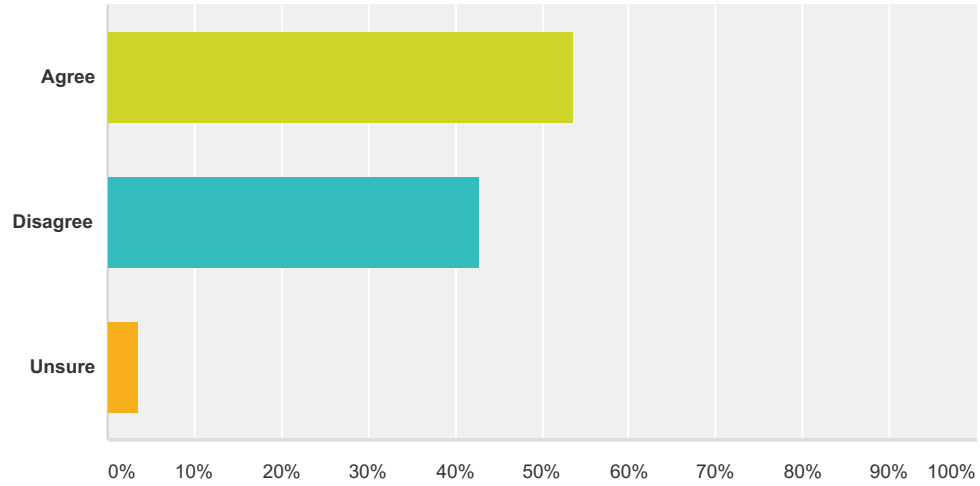

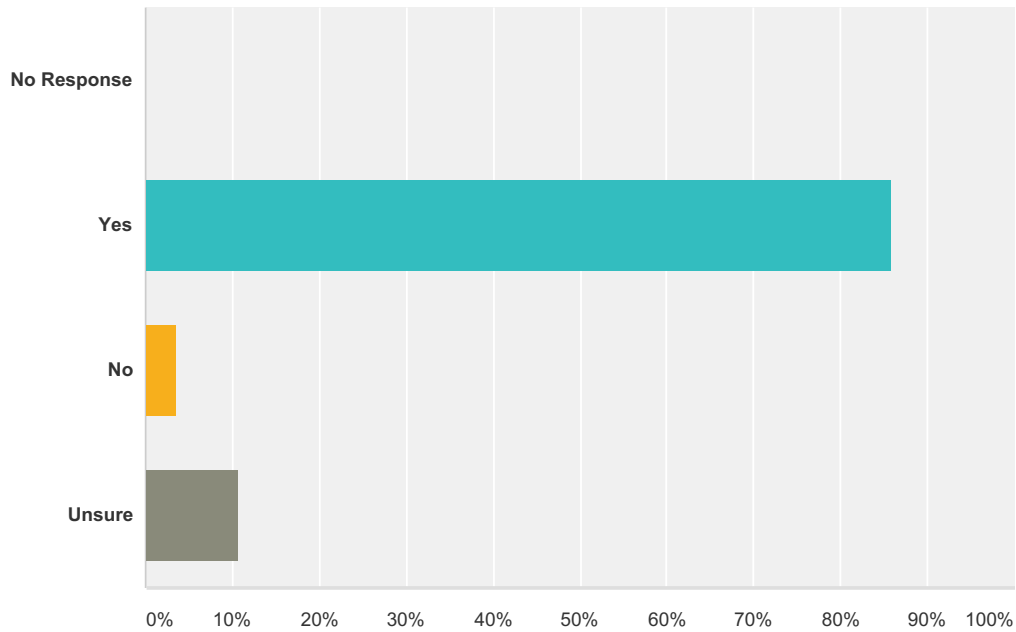

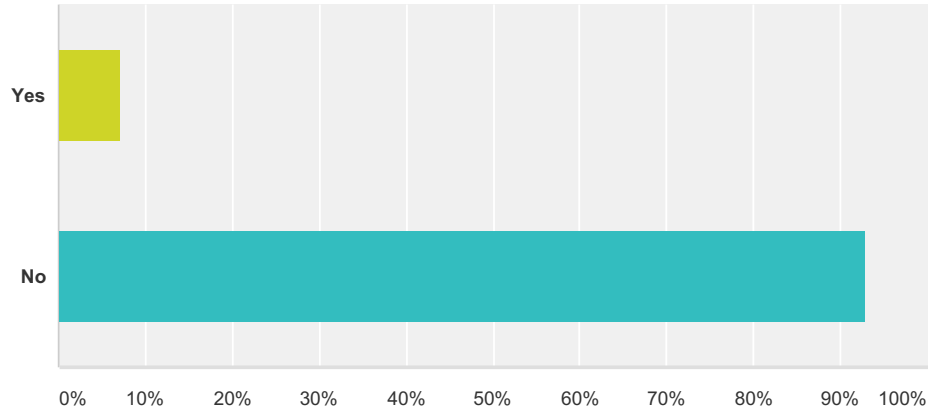
