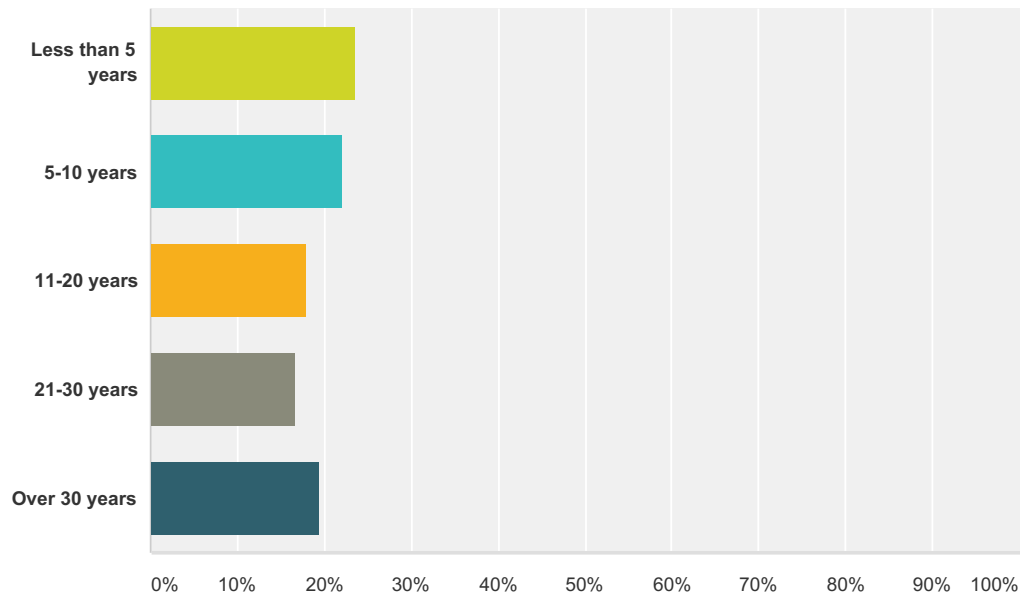

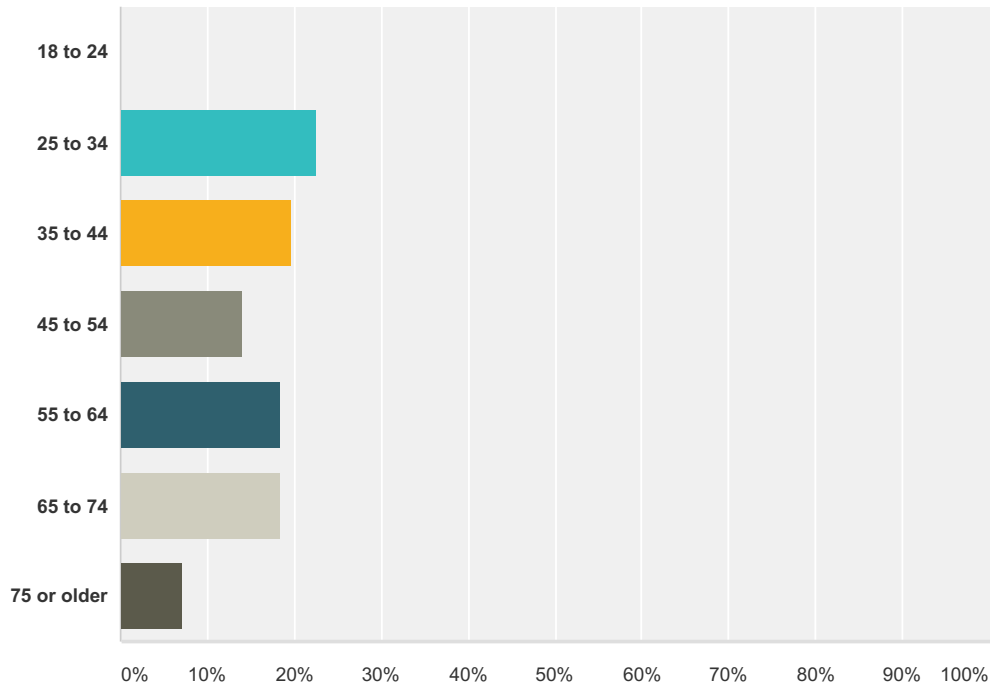

## Q2 What is your age?

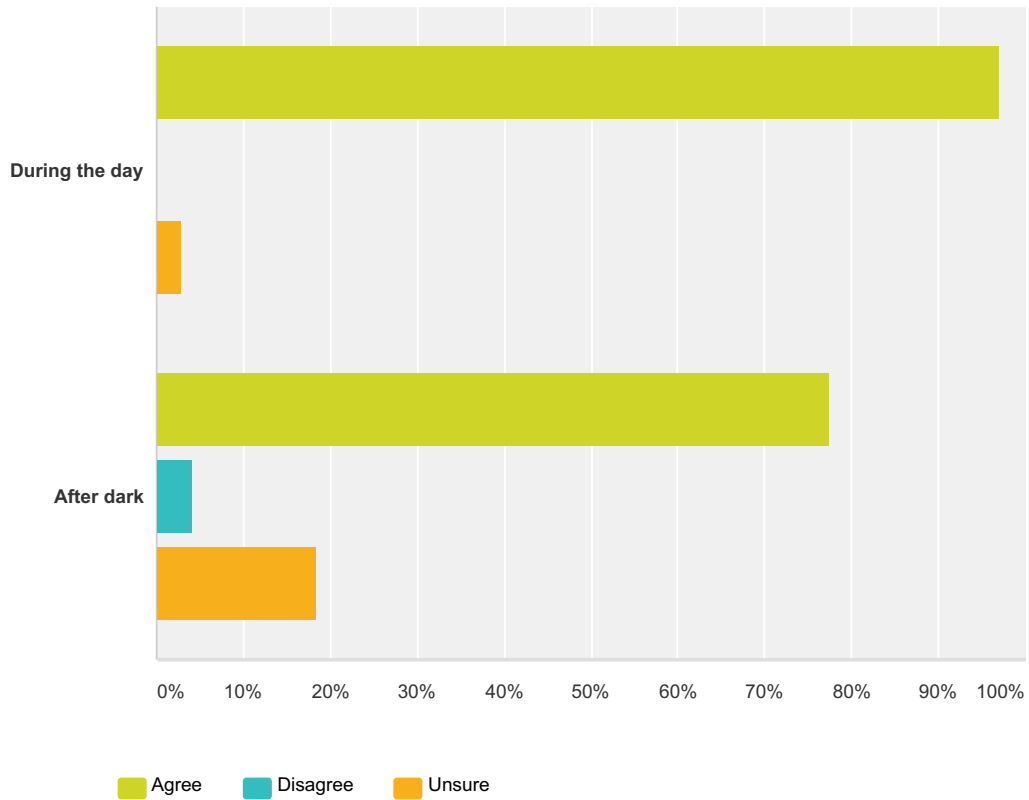

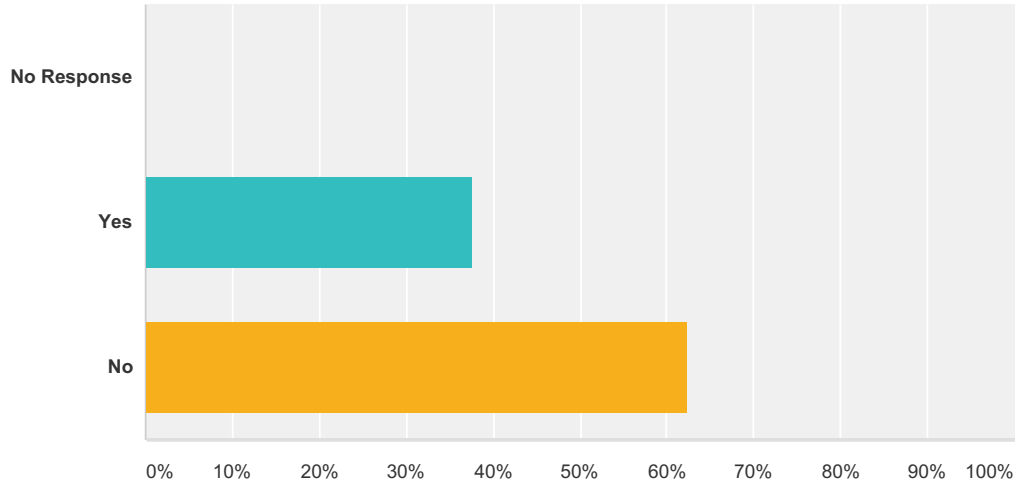
