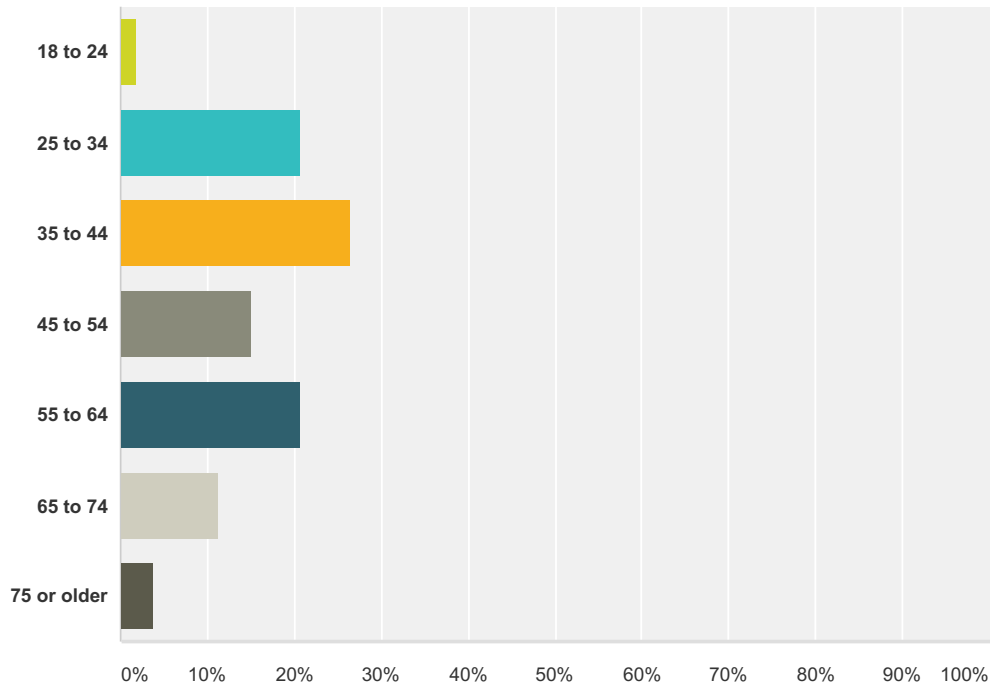

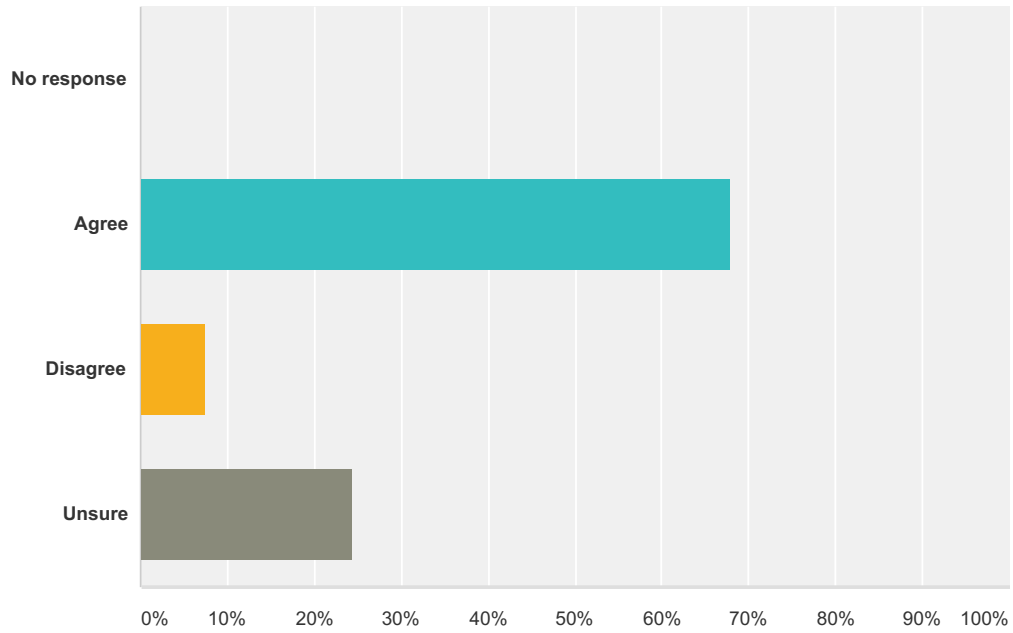

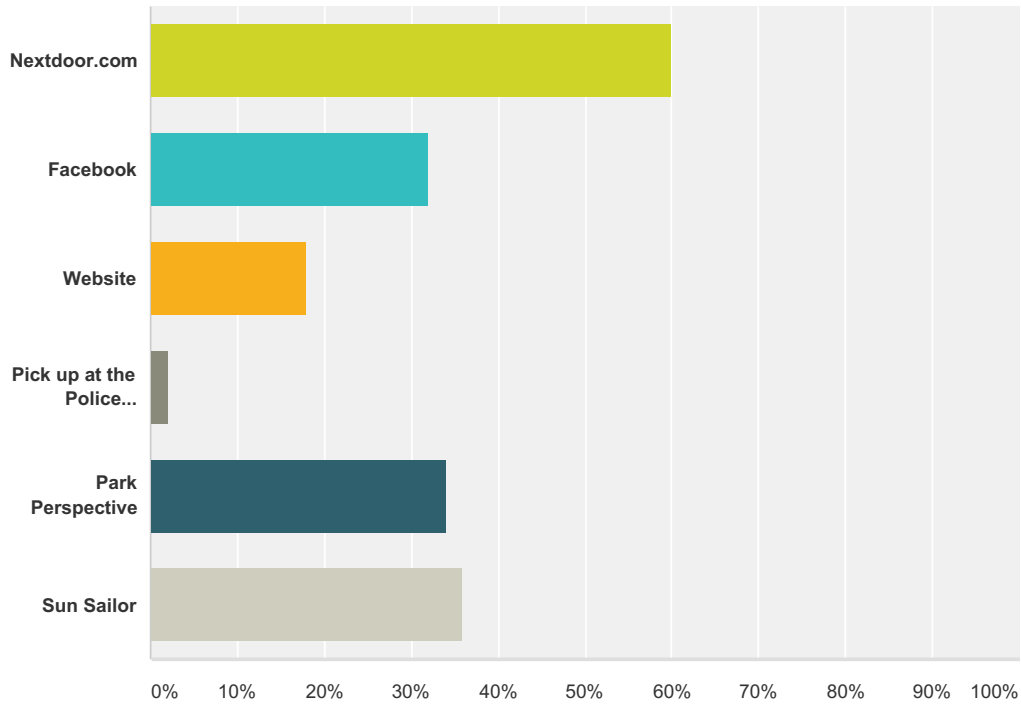

While I know the department didn't create the signs, I feel like a more confident and responsible agency wouldn't feel the need to have gratitude for its services advertised or accept donations as a result. Yes, it is nice that there is some kind of community being reflected in this, but there is real danger in not examining the genesis/motivation behind the signs, even if the signs' creator truly believes herself to be doing something altruistic/helpful. I doubt that most people with these signs would want them were it not for Black Lives Matter and recent news events (not that there's necessarily anything wrong with that, either). Of course there is nothing wrong with people being thankful for police. I am happy to pay taxes for such things, and I want police to be properly compensated and have safe and productive working conditions (which I would think way more important to police employees than disposable 'thank you' signs). I am a white person, and I would gladly pay more to know that my city's police department was committed to fairness and equality, or at the very least, the appearance thereof. Why is it so hard for so many to unequivocally state "Yes, Black Lives Matter"? A really meaningful gesture would be to discourage the 'Thank You' signs and donate that extra money to Black Lives Matter or to do something else to help people see that you support racial and social justice. I hope the department will participate in the Human Rights Commission discussion on this topic! Because all it's going to take is one incident like the one in Edina, and you'll have a significant part of SLP wanting to have people fired, etc. I'm just thinking you could head this off and prevent the politicization of the police in our neighborhoods, which I'm afraid the signs contribute to. If you read the discussion on Nextdoor about Black Lives Matter signs, you would see that the existence of the 'Thank You' signs is just encouraging people to 'take sides' in a phenomenon that shouldn't have to be divisive in this way. Driving through my neighborhood, when I see a 'Thank You SLP Police' sign, I think, "this person, maybe a little naively, 'supports' police (because who doesn't?!) and dismisses the Black Lives Matter movement, and by extension, so does SLP Police". Maybe that's my own bias, but I try to be evenhanded and nonjudgmental about these things. Do others? I worry most people see these in the same way that they see opposing pairs of political lawn signs (and as I said, the evidence available points this way), particularly this fall. Is that how the department wants to situate itself in this climate? An honest question. And to further demonstrate my point, I am afraid to leave contact information with this comment.
