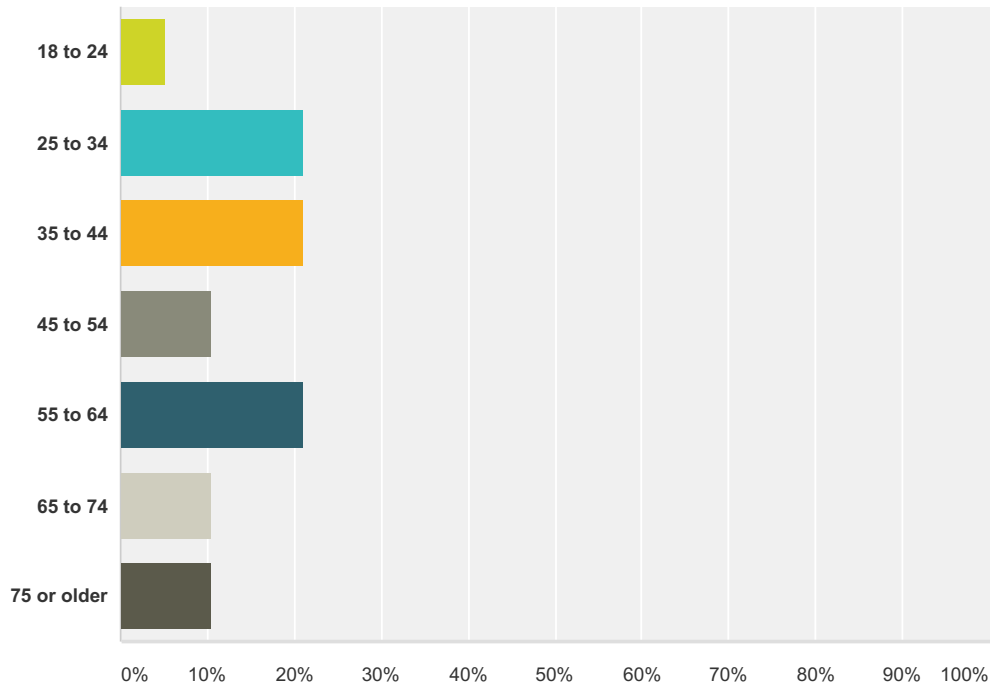

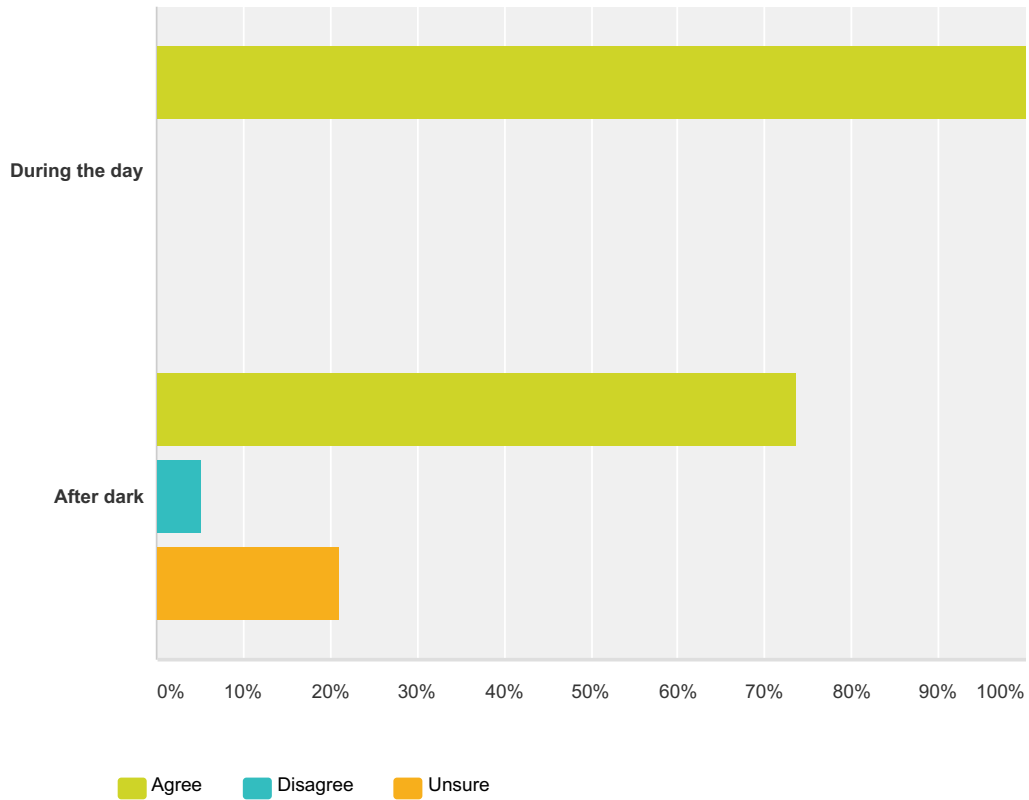

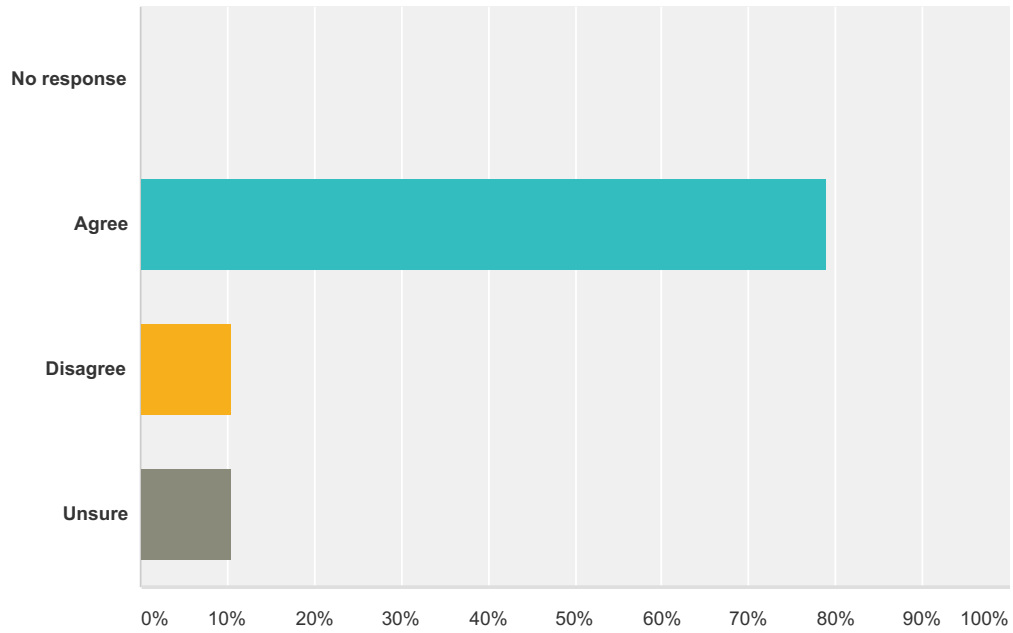

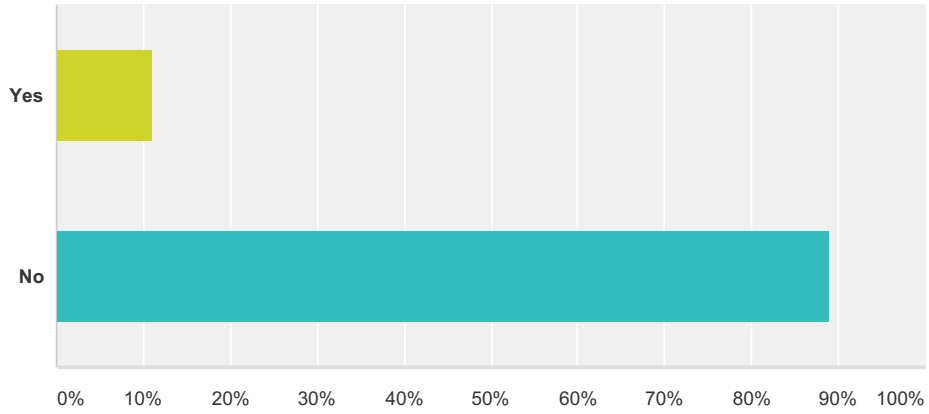

6	Eliot View Road between Hampshire and Edgewood is designated with "parking permit required" parking restrictions which are NOT enforced. 98% of the vehicles parked on the street on any given Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday evenings do NOT have permits and there are excessive vehicles parked on the street (sometimes causing the street to be impassible). The majority of the vehicles are parked within the 67xx block of Eliot View Road. I have called the non-emergency number regarding this issue on several occasions and have received rude, non-helpful comments from the individuals answering the non-emergency PD number. While I am aware that parking issues are of lesser importance to the PD, I feel that they should be handled with respect when citizens call regarding the issues especially when the street is clearly marked with signs indicating "No Thru Traffic" and "Parking Permit Required".	10/19/2016 3:18 PM
