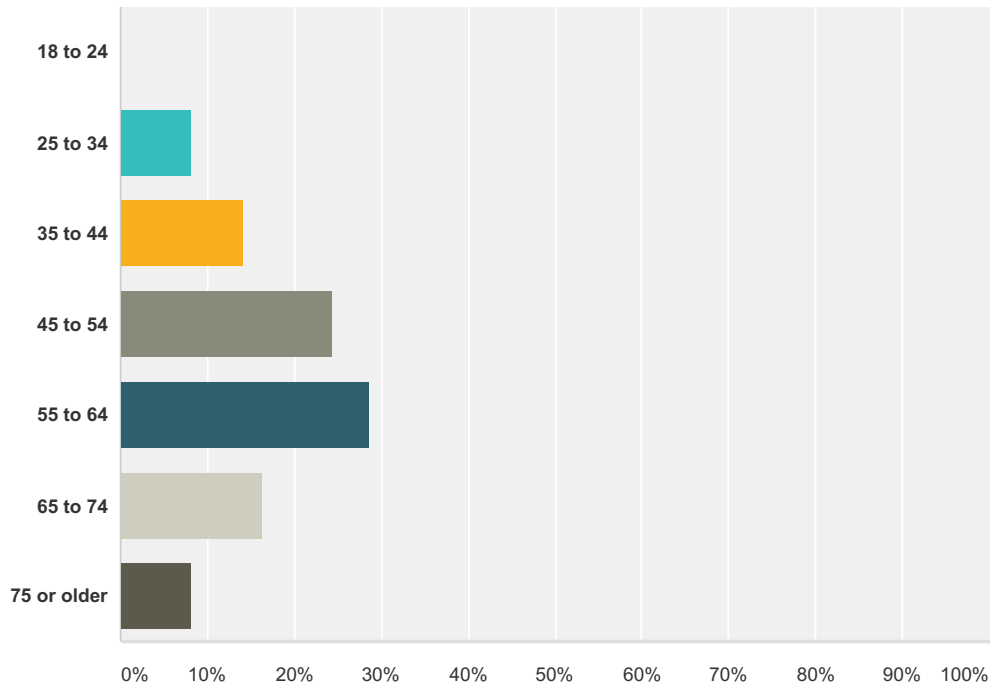

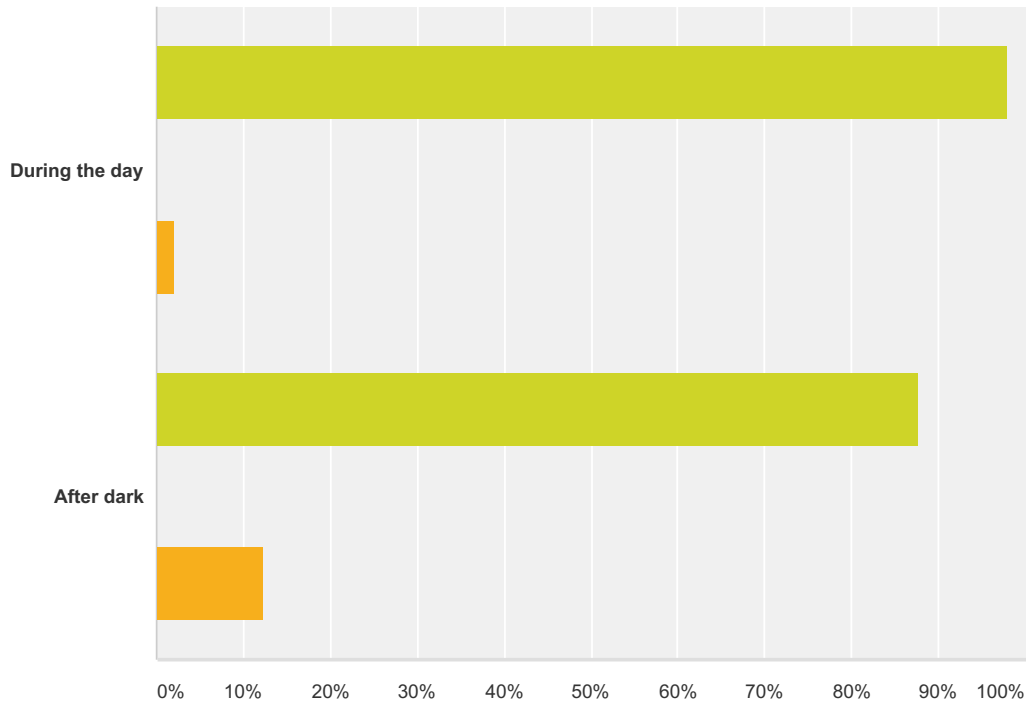

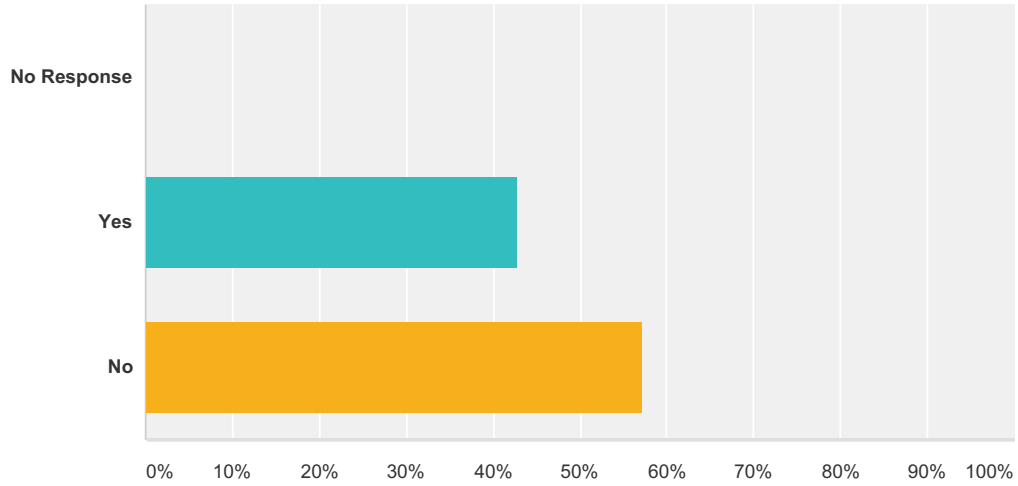

5	<p>Some people walk their dogs &amp; allow them to do "their business" in our yard (8137 Westwood Hills Dr.) -- it's not a public park! This happens everyday throughout the day. It'd be greatly appreciated if people kept their dogs on a short lease out of neighborhood yards &amp; had the dogs do "their business" in a public park (that allows dogs) -- or better yet, have them do "their business" in their own yard! Over the years, we've struggled with maintaining our yard - - as disgusting as it is for dogs pooping in our yard (especially when it's not picked up), the urine is actually more destructive. It feels like we're constantly fighting a losing battle to repair the damage their dogs do to our yard (wish we could fence in our entire yard). Some people train &amp; manage their dogs very well &amp; those people are never a problem. Other people don't want to be bothered to have to take the extra time &amp; effort to control their pets so they're not a problem for the neighborhood. (Many people are displeased with disrespectful dog walkers, but most people are afraid to say anything.) We've politely asked some of the offenders to keep their dogs out of our yard -- most people respond: "oops, sorry, won't happen again." But there are those who continue to ignore the request &amp; others who purposely repeat the offense (to make a point?). And then there are some who argue. A couple of years ago one woman came charging at me like she was going to assault me, starting yelling at me, stomping on the ground. Of course I called the police, but didn't press charges, because I hoped it'd blow over, but I wanted her behavior "on record" in the event she continued her alarming behavior. She &amp; her friends continued to walk their dogs by our property (which is fine), but sometimes they'd allow the dog in our yard, one time all of them sitting in our yard for about 10 minutes. I ignored their bad behavior, in the hope that they'd get tired of behaving immaturely &amp; disrespectfully &amp; move on. In the past year or so it doesn't seem to happen as much any more. It would be nice if the city listed guidelines in their newsletters on how to manage dogs, &amp; also enlisted dog training businesses (like PetSmart) to train dog owners to manage their dogs in respectful ways. There also are people who walk their dogs "off lease." And some people's dogs are constantly escaping, running throughout the neighborhood, harassing other dogs, walkers, bikers, etc. (it can be a safety issue). Also, some people let their dog spend time in their fenced backyard, but then the dog begins to bark for long periods before they're brought back inside -- this can be an annoying problem, especially if one's trying to rest or recover from an illness. A little help from the city &amp; law enforcement would hopefully help remedy these problems.
